**Traineeships gives you the opportunity to attend a training programme at SWFC where you will gain crucial employability and work related skills with qualified assessors.**

You will gain valuable work experience on a placement with a professional football club or employer in South Yorkshire, understanding and developing in a work environment. There are two types of traineeships to accommodate both 16-18 year olds and 19-24 year olds.

*In addition, if you are aged 19 - 24, you have the optional choice of gaining a level 1 qualification in Customer Service. A vital key skill that most employers are looking for.*



Sheffield Wednesday will work closely with the trainee in making sure the placement is right, and with the employer in making sure the programme runs smoothly for the whole 13 week duration.
